

State of Illinois School Health Requirements

Deadlines are listed, but forms can be turned in at any time.

Pre-Kindergarten:

Due October 15: Immunizations (HIB, Hepatitis B, MMR, DTP, Polio, Varicella, Pneumococcal) and physical exam on "Certificate of Child Health" form. **NOTE:** *If in Pre-K for more than 1 year, no additional documentation needed.*

Kindergarten:

Due October 15: Physical exam performed on "Certificate of Child Health" form, immunizations (DTP/Tdap, Polio, Varicella, MMR), and eye exam completed by ophthalmologist/optometrist. **NOTE:** *If no eye exam is completed, a waiver MUST be submitted by October 15.*

Due May 15: Dental Exam on Illinois form or dental waiver form.

Grade 2:

Due May 15: Dental Exam on Illinois form or dental waiver form.

Grade 6:

Due October 15: Physical exam performed on "Certificate of Child Health" form and immunizations (Tdap, Varicella, MMR, Meningococcal-given on or after the 11th birthday).

Due May 15: Dental Exam with completed form or dental waiver form.

Grade 9:

Due October 15: Physical exam performed on "Certificate of Child Health" form and updated immunization record (Tdap, Varicella, MMR).

Due May 15: Dental Exam on Illinois form or dental waiver form.

Grade 12:

Due October 15: Second Meningococcal vaccine-given on or after the 16th birthday.

Students new to the State of Illinois: Physical exam performed on the State of Illinois Certificate form with completed Immunizations, an Illinois Eye Exam or waiver, an Illinois Dental Exam or waiver, and Updated health history form.

Sports Physical: If your child will be participating in sports, they must have a current sports physical on file. A school physical completed on the Certificate of Child Health form can be used in lieu of a sports physical; however, a sports physical **CANNOT** be accepted as a school physical.

Dental Clinic: There is a **FREE** dental clinic held at the school by the Dewitt-Piatt Health Department each fall. This is available to ALL students. This will cover the State of Illinois required school dental exam for grades K, 2, 6, and 9. Paperwork will be sent home in the fall and needs to be completed if interested.
